
Coach - Official Interaction

- The importance of coach official interaction cannot be overstated
- I suggest we all have a 'blueprint'
- Every official and coach are different
- Be Yourself (have the courage to be who you are). Abraham Lincoln
- Poise/Composure/Body Language
- Rules Knowledge will enhance your communication skills

- 1. Look the coach directly in the eye. Do NOT cover your mouth!
- 2. Let the coach have his say (hear and listen)
- 3. Respond in a calm, firm manner. Do NOT yell/scream



- There is no need to be "right'
- Stay Professional
- Okay to use the 'stop sign'
- Say, "coach, I'm trying to work with you."
- Never embarrass the coach in front of his players

- 5. Have a 'line of demarcation'
